SWEEPSTAKES

The Sweepstakes competition will be for Dogs and Bitches which are 6 months and under 18 months of age on the date of the sweepstakes competition. **Must also be entered in a regular conformation class.** Classes (**all coats combined**) will be divided by age and sex as follows:

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP CLASSES

(Note: additional information required on back of entry form)

NOVICE CLASS: This class shall be for boys and girls, who at the time entries close, have not won their three first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN CLASS: This class shall be for boys and girls who have won three first place awards in a Novice class in a licensed or member show, with competition present. The winner of a Novice Class shall automatically become eligible, upon notice to the Open Class ring steward, to enter and compete in the Open Class at the same show provided the win is the 3rd first place award with competition and further providing there are one or more junior handlers competing in the Open Class.

The Novice and Open classes will be divided into **Junior, Intermediate and Senior** classes.

The **Junior** class is for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show.

The **Intermediate** class shall be for the boys and girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years on the day of the show.

The **Senior** class shall be for boys and girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show.

BEST JUNIOR HANDLER: The junior handler placed first in each of the regular Junior Showmanship Classes, if undefeated in any other Junior Showmanship Class at this show, shall automatically be eligible to compete for this prize.

**** Brace Class.** The Brace class will be for two dogs of the same breed and capable of performing the Novice exercises. The dogs need not be owned by the same person but will be handled by one handler. Dogs may be shown unattached or coupled (the coupling device will not be less than 6 inches in overall length). A separate official entry form will be completed in full for each dog entered. Either or both dogs in a brace may be entered in another class or classes.

Obedience & Rally Move-Ups (will be allowed for these trials)

After a dog earns a title, it may be moved up to the next class in a future trial even though the closing date for the trial has passed. This move up may be requested if, according to the owner's records, the dog has completed the requirements for the title after the closing date of the trial in which the advanced entry is to be made. The request for a move-up must be in writing and presented to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. Move-ups may be approved, provided the next level of class and judge is available and the class has not reached its limit.

Move-up forms may be downloaded from the AKC website (www.akc.org) and/or will also be available at the secretary's table.

AKC New Exhibitor Briefing

The New Exhibitor Briefing will help new exhibitors understand the dog show and feel more comfortable with the sport. The briefing will explain the duties of the superintendent or show secretary, the AKC Executive Field Staff, the event committee, the ring steward, ring location, exercise areas, and assist with grooming space. We will explain dog show classes, points computation, and verification of placements (judges book tear sheets). All exhibitors, new and seasoned, are welcome to participate. There is no cost for this briefing, but we ask that you sign up with the show secretary.

The briefing will be held near the conformation ring, beginning one hour before conformation judging on Saturday, March 10.

Rally Obedience is excluded from the entry counts in the determination of awards.

SHOW REGULATIONS

- All **heavy grooming** and use of grooming products (chalk, sprays, etc.) must be used in the south (small) room only. No hair dryers allowed in the north (large) room.
- **Light grooming** (limited clipping, brushing, combing) may be done in the north (large) room.
- Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.
- Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring.
- There will be no refund for duplicate entries.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes, or any other cause beyond the control of the Club.
- No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Entries will not be accepted without fees or signatures.
- Changes, additions, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing (e-mail acceptable) or by telegram only prior to the closing of entries.
- If a bitch entered in the obedience or rally classes comes in season after the Trial's closing date, the entry will be refunded at 50%. This will be done upon receipt by the Trial secretary of a veterinarian's certificate stating such condition. This notification must be received prior to the start time of each day's obedience and/or rally trial(s) in order to receive the refund.
- The show giving Club, their agents, employees, etc. assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by the exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.
- Parents are responsible for supervising their children.
- Owners and Handlers are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs and children.
- No Smoking in the building.
- Dogs may **NOT** be left in the grooming room overnight.
- **Mats must be used under metal crates. Also grooming tables and/or chairs if they do not have rubber feet.**
- Exhibitors and spectators are expected to keep the grounds clean. Please pick up after your dogs.
- **Anyone witnessed not picking up after his/her dog will be excused from the specialty weekend with no monies refunded.**
